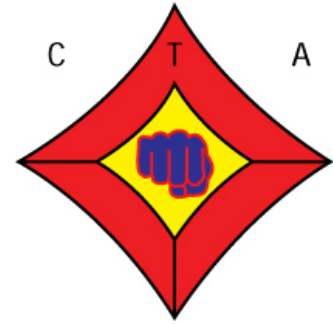

The Central Taekwondo Association (CTA) is active in the education, promotion, and stabilization of the Martial Arts. In essence, the CTA is a modern institution, but it still retains strong traditional ties and heritage. Many different facets of the Martial Arts are represented within the CTA and are certified within the CTA structure. Applied interests of the CTA range from the Women's Anti-Assault Program (WAAP) for the physically untrained woman, to Mixed Martial Arts training, and includes active involvement in international, national and local martial arts including karate (Korean and otherwise) and Police Self Defense Instructors training.

The Central Technical Authority of the CTA provides the background necessary for the development of good physical skills, tournaments, certification, et cetera. It can help you with legitimizing dan promotions, developing your dojang requirements and curriculum and help with the business of running a dojo.

Any legitimate Martial Arts or group may join which meet to practice the martial arts. Participating members of the CTA are active individuals participating in various activities common to the martial arts. Dan and kup registration, certification or promotion is available to both individuals and dojangs. Instructor credentials can also be issued. Finally, honorary membership is given by designation to any individual or group that has given outstanding service to this organization or the martial arts in general.

Application for membership must include a full resume and the background of the member. It should show name, rank, and address of the sponsor, and the appropriate fee should accompany the application. Upon the approval of the Application Committee, charters, identification cards, certificates, patches and newsletters will be tendered.

Having joined the CTA, the applicant is encouraged to participate in the interests of his choice.
